Minor Design Project

Final Major Project

Building upon previous learning, students engage in an extensive design project, addressing real-world scenarios with externally set briefs. They focus on resolving complex design challenges, culminating in a comprehensive project that showcases their capabilities.

Credit Points: 80

Dissertation

Students negotiate a research project relevant to interior architecture, resulting in a 5,000-word written or visual dissertation. This module emphasizes critical thinking and in-depth exploration of a chosen topic within the field.
